**ITEM:** Conflict of Interest Statements. All persons present at the officers' meeting received a copy of the OC conflicts of interest policy, Article VII of the bylaws and signed an annual conflict of interest statement.

split the profits from the Double Decker ride between Nine Lives Cat Rescue, Friends of Pete, and ALS (in lieu of Ryan not being able to hold a Spin-A-Thon due to the amount of work he's doing for DDSR. Christian Stovall is handling the design of the tee shirts and is planning on using Bluff City Sports to print them. Carol asked where the OC recyclable shopping bag were for swag. Jason said he thought Vivian had them. Carol asked about purchasing strobe light for SAG drivers to place on their vehicles. There was some discussion about doing a mass email via racesonline and to BikeWalk Mississippi. Jason volunteered his house for Friday evening packet pick-up. He mentioned that Saturday morning sign-ups needed to be cash or check only.
